Any business activity carried out by a private employer is non-mandatorily covered. Any business activity carried out by a municipal or regional government or a related board or agency is mandatorily covered under Schedule 2.

NAICS summary:

This Canadian industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in providing non-instructional services that support educational processes or systems.

Included examples:

- child guidance centre, vocational
- child guidance clinic, education
- consultants, education
- curriculum development, educational
- educational counselling
- educational literature and support services
- educational test development
- educational testing services
- school noon-hour supervision, service
- school-yard monitoring services
- student exchange programs
- vocational counselling (except rehabilitation)
- vocational guidance centres

Exclusions:

- job placement services (See 561310 Employment placement agencies and executive search services)
- job training for the unemployed, underemployed, physically disabled, and persons who have a job market disadvantage because of lack of education or job skills (See 624310 Vocational rehabilitation services)
- vocational rehabilitation services (See 624310 Vocational rehabilitation services)
